LITERACY

In Literacy, our Early Learning target is to be able to read and understand a simple sentence as well as being able to write one. All children are now encouraged to write in sentences and we think that our topic of "Let's Find Out!" will help us with this.

OUR FOCUS

We will be continuing with phonics through the Read, Write, Inc scheme and will be starting to focus a little more on how we can use our phonic knowledge to write, maybe even writing our own stories.

MATHS

In Mathematics, we will be consolidating our skills with number by making sure we can all confidently count, recognise and order numbers to 20, and solve tricky problems including sharing and counting in groups. We will revisit shapes, time and money.

OUR THEME

At the end of Term 4, the children in Chestnut Class were very inquisitive about how things sound and what they were like. They asked tricky questions such as, "What does a seahorse sound like?" We are therefore going to spend this term being inquisitive about our world, think of things we want to know and then say, "Let's find out!".
