Dear Y4 Parents and Guardians

As part of Year 4's Learning Journey they have been reading 'Varjak Paw' by S F Said since January. The book tells the story of a small Mesopotamian Blue cat and his journey after his family is split apart.

As part of the children's Fantastic Finish we have organised a Henna Workshop on **Wednesday 14th March**. During the ancient times of Mesopotamia, henna was used to dye skin and hair as well as fabrics including silk, wool and leather very much as it is today. The children will learn how to create many different and inspirational patterns and designs on a medium of their choice– not their skin!

The children should come to school this day with any **two** of the following: a white pillar candle (approx. 15cm tall), a light coloured flat stone (fist sized) or a plain mug. The children will then get to bring home their beautiful designs.

The cost of the workshop is £5.09 per child. You are not obliged to contribute and no child will be excluded on financial grounds.
