Some key areas we will be covering are:-

- Place Value
- Rounding
- Four Operations – addition, subtraction, multiplication and division
- Order of Operations
- Fractions, Decimals and Percentages

The Year 6 Team feel that "**Big Maths Beat That!**" has really helped in raising the standard in pupils recall of number/multiplication facts and this will, therefore, continue alongside the revision tasks mentioned above and Maths Passports.
