We have been informed today that 11+ testing will move to September from ***this year***. Please see information below.

**SECONDARY ADMISSION SCHEME FOR 2009**

We received a decision from the Secretary of State at 12pm today advising what Secondary School Admission arrangements will apply for 2009. This is an imposed Scheme, which is binding on all Kent's schools and academies.

As initially proposed after consultation by the Kent County Council Cabinet, Kent grammar school testing will move to September. In order to be able to administer this change, parents will be required to pre-register to sit the test. Registration opens on 2nd June 2008 and will close on 11 July 2008.

We have today sent by first class post the following publicity materials to all primary schools - a poster for display in a prominent area within the school and flyers to be given to all Year 5 pupils/parents. In addition now we have confirmation from the Secretary of State, registration forms and information relating to registration for the Kent 11+ Test have gone to print. This material will be in schools by 2nd June for distribution to parents.
