Dear Parents

Welcome back to school, whether you are an 'old hand' or have joined the school this term. I hope that you have had a wonderful summer.

New staff - This term we welcome our new teachers; Mrs Alkureishi (Deputy Headteacher and Year 6), Miss Perolls (Year 4), Miss Kemp (Year 4), Miss Clarke (Year 3) and Miss Ritman-Meer (Year 2). They are all excited about the year ahead and have been working hard in preparation.

Update on premises – It has been a relief not to spend the summer in chaos because there have been no major building projects. However, we have had a new playground surface and markings laid which will make playtime and PE lesson safer and more exciting for the children. In addition, three of our junior classes have had classrooms double glazed. This has certainly smartened up the look of the school and will keep those rooms warmer in winter. At the end of last term we also had the Wrap Around Care facilities re-decorated which has made a huge difference.

Meet the Teacher Meetings - These are all scheduled for Monday 8th September for Years 2 to 6. Each teacher will hold 2 sessions commencing at 3.20pm and 4pm in classrooms. We would appreciate it if parents could seek childcare for toddlers. The hall will be made available for parents to mind children during these sessions. Parents should ensure that they have made an arrangement for another parent to supervise their children in the hall beforehand.

Parent Reps - We are looking for volunteers to come forward to be Parent Reps for Nursery, Chestnut, Olive, Mulberry, Maple, Sycamore, Redwood, and Oak! Please give this some thought and let the office know if you would like to be involved. The Parent Reps meet approximately once a term and the purpose of the meetings is to give Parent Reps an opportunity to meet the Headteacher, ask questions, receive feedback and discuss ideas. **Parents should still raise specific queries they have directly with teachers.**

Clubs – The letter about after school activities will be out in the next week. This will be sent home in book bags. Please read it carefully as there will be lots of information in it.

Bethany Gaved – It was a year ago last weekend that Beth Gaved sadly died after leaving Bishops Down to start secondary school. Our thoughts are with Tracey, Andrew and Luke during this difficult time. I am pleased to say that the PSA have arranged for a plaque to be added to the new outdoor classroom commemorating Beth and her extraordinary life. We know that Beth really enjoyed being outside and so this is a fitting tribute to her. The plaque reads,

Reminders about attendance

- What happens if my child is late? Registration finishes at 9.05 in the morning and 1.35 in the afternoon. If your child arrives after 9.05am or 1.35pm he/she will be marked as absent. Pupils who arrive after 9.00am should report to the school office and parents should sign their child in the late book. Excessive unauthorised "lates" will be referred to the Education Welfare Officer (EWO).
- Does the School need letters explaining my child's absence or will a phone call do? We would expect a parent to telephone the school on the first day of absence, and each day after that unless we have been told the child will be off for a prolonged period. If you do not phone us, we will contact you by mid-morning. This is because we believe it is our responsibility to ensure your child's safety as well as their regular school attendance.
