**Safer Internet Day 2015** - Safer Internet Day (SID) is organised in the UK by the UK Safer Internet Centre in February of each year to promote the safe and responsible use of online technology for children and young people. At Bishops Down we have been learning about e-Safety through a range of activities. A fact sheet is available on our school website via the parent tab/e-safety.

These will take place on a Monday (starting after half term) and will run from 3.20 to 4pm. Please feel free to come along and see what you can find.

**Swimming Gala** – Several children took part in the Primary Schools Gala on Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> February at St John’s pool. Congratulations to Lili, Ben, Laurie, Euan, Elle, and Betty who won the Mixed Medley Relay, and also to Jack for stepping in at the last minute to swim back stroke for the team.



**Sainsbury’s vouchers** – This scheme is running again and our collection box is in the entrance hall for any vouchers you can collect and donate to school, thank you.

**KS2 Choir Club** – Please note that all the children who applied for a space in this club starting after half term have been successful in obtaining a place. The first session is on Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> February 3.15-4pm.

**Reminder - Issues after school on the playground and rear field** - We are having a number of issues with parents and children staying on the school site after school for a long time. Our expectation is that most parents and children will have left the site by 3.30pm and those collecting children from Nursery by 3.40pm. Our priority must be the safety of children involved in after school hours activities. Staff leading these activities are struggling to monitor pupils and deliver their clubs effectively as there are so many other children still in school.

In addition we are having issues with children being allowed to use the castle, outdoor classroom and play equipment unsupervised after school. To clarify the position, children are not allowed to play on the equipment behind Reception classrooms after school hours. I have asked staff to be vigilant about this for the sake of all our children and they will ask children to leave the area.

**Nut allergies** – Please can parents remember that we have a number of children and staff with a severe nut allergy so we aim to keep a nut free environment at break and lunch times. We ask that parents do not send in snacks or any other food into school which may contain nuts.

**PSA Dinner Dance** - The PSA are still looking for donations for our auction at the Dinner Dance on the 21st March. If anyone has anything they would be able to donate then please do let us know. We will be announcing all prizes beforehand and will be able to advertise any companies who have donated.

**Walk on Wednesday** – There seems to be some confusion amongst the children as to whether they should be putting their hands up for inclusion each week in the Walk on Wednesday count for those children who walked to school. If your child walks or scoots on a Wednesday all the way to school, or further than they normally do the rest of the week, i.e *at least the length of Rydal Drive and Coniston Avenue*, then they should put their hand up to be included. These figures are sent to the scheme organisers each week, and are what we base the Golden Boot award on each Friday in Celebration Assembly.
