Dear Parents,

Thank you to all the parents that attended the Early Years and YR 1 meetings in school over the past two weeks, it has been great to hear directly from you. All notes have now been sent out and I will book a parent rep meeting shortly after half term to follow up on any subsequent concerns.

Some parents have been in touch regarding the comments about Reading in the Ofsted report. We have been undertaking training as a staff to refresh our skills and you should have noticed a renewed focus in every class on reading. EYFS and year 1 have had, or will be having sessions for parents on Early reading and phonics. All children are accessing the library and Griff our reading dog is busy every Friday hearing children read! If you would like to hear children read in school please let us know.

Behaviour was also mentioned on the Ofsted report. As you will understand, I cannot publically discuss individual behaviour matters due to confidentiality, however Governors are taking a keen interest in this area and have undertaken visits to classrooms and the playground to see how behaviour is managed. With regards to the most drastic sanction, exclusion (now known as suspension) Governors are informed and procedures discussed.

This week Governors have been in school to look at safeguarding procedures, as well as behaviour. They are satisfied that the school is following protocols and routines. The one area I would like to draw to your attention to is the school car park; this is where parents can support with safety. Friday afternoons we have 'All In Club', DramaNuts Club and Football Club all leaving at the same time and last Friday it was incredibly congested and therefore dangerous. Car park signage clearly states 'Staff and Visitor Car Park'. Parents are not permitted to use the car park for club collection—the only exception to this is collection from Beehive, even then we would prefer parents to park and walk to the school. Thank you
