Senior Gym Club - There are still spaces available in this club for Years 3 to 6. Please complete the reply slip below if your child would like a place.

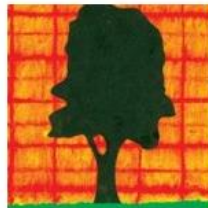
Blooming Britain 2013 'ecoArtcard' project
