## Headlice

child's hair weekly using a nit comb. This is an issue we, the school, can't enforce and have no control over we rely on parents to do the right thing. Please note that all children must put their hair up if shoulder length, preferably in plaits or a bun. If a child does not have their hair up the school will request that they do. I know that girls leave home with their hair up (thank you) only to then let it down at school – they wear their hairbands on their wrists! The staff are continuously nagging them and it would be appreciated if you could have a word at home please. This time of year headlice become prolific and we are getting complaints already from parents who are continually treating and tying up hair only to find their child catches it again. If we all do this, boys too, then maybe just maybe we can win.
