Hair - We have been asked to remind parents of children with long hair to tie hair back with hair bands and grips. Headlice love to investigate new places to live and can do so easily by hopping

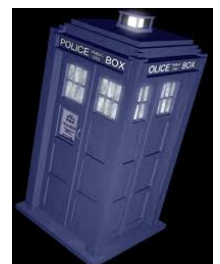
