### PE Kits to be kept in school

When children began to return to school after the lockdown in 2020, we followed advice from the local authority on how to minimise the risk of transmitting the COVID-19 virus between home and school. To help with this, children were discouraged from bringing bags, lunchboxes, books and PE bags to and from home. A decision was made that whilst COVID restrictions were in place, we would allow children to come into school on PE days in their PE kits and this is what children have done since then.

We have now decided that due to concerns about children's hygiene and also due to the impact that children coming into school in PE kit has had on the standards of school uniform, we will return to asking children to bring PE kit in and change for PE in school.

As well as being more hygienic, changing for PE in school allows younger children to develop their independence from parents and learn how to dress themselves.

From next week, we ask that all children wear school uniform to school everyday. They will need to bring into school a named PE bag that will contain the school PE kit. This will stay in school until half—term when it will return home to be washed!
