Parking in Rydal Drive

Changes to Home Learning Provision at Bishops Down

Children who are unable to attend school due to COVID related isolation and are feeling well within themselves, should be accessing home learning each day to ensure they continue to make good progress this academic year. As we strive to continually improve our provision of Home Learning, we have looked to different technologies, which will enable us to share lessons with children in the most effective way. The online learning platform, which we have chosen, is Office 365 and Teams, in particular. This now allows us to share planning content and resources with children learning at home. We hope also to offer live or recorded lessons, which children at home can join virtually whilst isolating.

Nursery and Reception

How to Access Home Learning

Teachers will share their weekly plan on Tapestry using the memos section. This avoids the children's journals filling with observations that do not correspond with their learning and progress. This memo will be shared each Monday and throughout the week.

Years 1 - 6

Live Lessons

Children are also encouraged to log into Microsoft Teams to access live lessons where they will be able to either see the teacher or the shared screen and will get to hear the same input as the children who are learning in school. Your teacher will leave a message each morning to explain what time the live lessons will be starting that day. Once the lesson has started, you will see a 'Join now' button, which enables you to access the lesson.

Teams Assignments

Your child's class teacher will be uploading the lesson plans and resources for the same learning that is taking place in the classroom that week. These will be set as Assignments on Microsoft Teams on a daily or weekly basis.

To access Microsoft Teams, first log in with your child's log in details (sent to you over half term). You will have access to a year group team. Within this, you will see any assignments being set for you by your teacher. Some of these can be done online and sent straight back to you teacher for marking.

Your child will have access to daily lessons in:

Maths

Reading Skills

Writing/Topic

These should be completed each morning. In the afternoon, children should complete their final lesson by clicking on the Oak National Academy link and following the website to their year group. They must complete one lesson (not English or Maths) from this website. Children are encouraged to manage their own time-taking appropriate breaks as and when needed.
